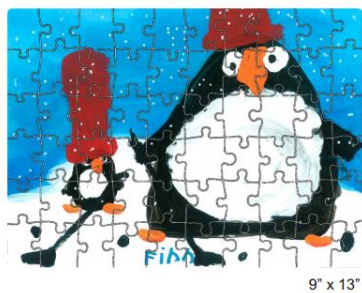
Plaques

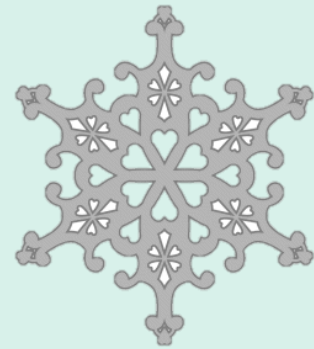
The next PAC General meeting is November 16th from 7-8pm in the library. Childcare and light refreshments will be provided.
