If you can volunteer as a general helper on April 21st, please fill out the volunteer portion of the student workshop selection form indicating your availability.

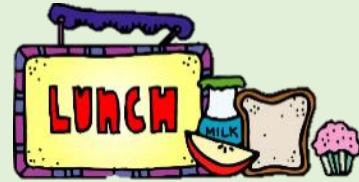
